Silver Lake Camp

Since 1921, Stockton Silver Lake Camp has hosted Campers escaping the heat and bustle of the city for a fresh, more peaceful setting. This historic Camp is located a half mile from Silver Lake in Amador County, which is nestled at the foot of Thunder Mountain in the majestic High Sierras. It is 100 miles east of Stockton on Highway 88 at an elevation of 7,300 feet, and is less than an hour from Lake Tahoe.



Stockton Silver Lake Camp is located on land that is leased by the City of Stockton from the United States Forest Service. We operate the camp with the understanding that we will not violate Forest Service regulations.



Accommodations

Silver Lake Camp offers fifty rustic, all-wood cabins. Each cabin is furnished with a double bed and two sets of bunk beds, dressers and chairs. You will need your own bedding or sleeping bags. The cabins have electric lights and outlets powered by a generator.* A modern, centrally-located bathhouse provides hot showers and laundry facilities. A pay phone for campers' use is conveniently located outside the Camp Office.

* **The generator will be TURNED OFF AT NIGHT!**

Please be sure to bring flashlights and plenty of batteries

If you use a sleep apnea machine, you will need to bring a battery pack for it.



Activities

During Family Camp your family and friends can enjoy a variety of recreational and social activities. Take part in our weekly Variety Show presented by and for the Campers. Enjoy a sing-a-long or skits by the campfire. There will also be hikes and activities



for kids and adults during the day.

You may do Arts & Crafts, Archery, Game Day, Kiddie Camp, Volleyball, Hiking and more. Evenings include Campfires, Bingo, Karaoke night, Variety Shows, and Game night.



Campers are also free to plan their own adventures. There are many hiking trails within a short distance of camp; swimming, kayaking, and fishing at the lake; or simply relaxing under the trees or enjoying a walk in one of the wildflower-filled meadows close to the camp.



Meals

Your stay at Silver Lake Camp includes three meals prepared each day by our kitchen staff. Breakfast may be Continental on some days. Lunch and dinner always include a salad bar. You may request a sack lunch at dinner if you expect to be away from camp for lunch the next day.



Enjoy your meals in our rustic lodge or outside on the patio. There are a limited number of high chairs and booster seats available for small children.

Cancellation Policy

****Campers who cancel part or all of their reservation before June 1st will forfeit their \$20 nonrefundable deposit for each night cancelled.**

****Cancellations after June 1st but before July 1st will forfeit 25% of the reservation cost for each night cancelled.**

****Cancellations after July 1st will forfeit 50% of the reservation cost for each night cancelled.**

****Campers leaving camp early MUST check out with the Camp Manager and give their reason for leaving early in order to be considered for a partial refund.**

Other Information

***Check in time is 3 PM; check out time is 11AM.** Campers are asked to sweep their cabins and empty the trash prior to checking out, so the cabin will be ready for the next camper.

*The Silver Lake Camp Store, with a variety of snacks and sundries, is located in the Lodge. Hours are posted.

*The Camp Nurse is available to take care of bumps, bruises, and scrapes, and to handle most emergency situations.

*Firearms and/or fireworks are **NOT permitted** in Camp. Camp stoves and other fire apparatus are also NOT permitted. Campfires are allowed **only** in the main campfire ring. Your cooperation with these Forest Service restrictions is appreciated.

*Pets are allowed but must be kept on a leash at all times. **Pets are NOT ALLOWED in the Lodge or bathroom areas.** Proof of vaccinations and a per-pet deposit of \$50 must be presented at check-in.

*The Silver Lake Chapel is located between Plasse's meadow and the lake. It offers a stunning view of Thunder Mountain and Silver Lake as a backdrop for Sunday services. Protestant services are at 10:00 am, Catholic Mass at noon.

*WiFi Internet service is available at nearby Plasse's resort for a reasonable connection fee.

The Silver Lake Campers Association is a non-profit group that has worked to support the City of Stockton's operation of Silver Lake Family Camp for more than 60 years. In the past, the Association has provided "those little extras" that enhance the Family Camp experience. Important Deadlines

***Campers who pre-reserved for 2011 Family Camp last year must complete the 2011 Reservation Form to the left and return it to the Campers Association by March 31st.** If we do not receive your form by this date, your cabin may be released to other campers.

***Campers who are added to an existing reservation after June 1 will each be charged a \$5 late registration fee in addition to the applicable reservation rates.** Added campers arriving at camp without prior 24 hour notice will be charged a \$10 late registration fee.

***Please fill out the Reservation Form at left and return it to the Campers Association, along with a 50% deposit, of which \$20 for each night reserved will serve as a non-refundable deposit.** Address is on the front of the brochure. See the cancellation policy at left. Call us or check our website for cabin availability.
